## **SENIOR TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. This tournament observes the rules of USBC and is certified by USBC.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Bowler must be 50 years of age or over, as of the date they bowl their first squad and a current USBC member. The entrant MUST be sanctioned in one of the 2 Delaware Associations (LDUSBC or NDUSBC) prior to the tournament.
- 3. EVENTS:
- a) This tournament will consist of doubles, singles and optional all-events.
- b) Doubles will be one division only. Any two (2) bowlers age 50 or older may team up (either 2 men or 2 women or 1 man and 1 woman). You do **NOT** have to be in the same age group.
- c) Bowlers may enter doubles and/or singles multiple times. If a bowler enters doubles more than once, he/she must have a different partner for each entry.
- d) In order to be eligible for All-Events, the bowler must bowl in both doubles and singles.
- e) In order to be eligible for the National Seniors Entry, the bowler must bowl in both doubles and singles, and must pay the optional All-Events fee.
- 4. The paid all-events winner in each age division will be eligible to enter the USBC National Senior Tournament. If a bowler enters doubles and/or singles multiple times and has paid the optional all-events fee, the first score bowled in each event will be the score used to determine the qualifying national all-events score. If the winner elects not to attend, the tournament director will go to the next highest all-events score in that age class. This will continue for up to the 3<sup>rd</sup> position, at that point no bowler will be sent.
- 5. Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners on a handicap basis for each division. Prize fees will be returned 100%. Unused expense money will be added to the prize fund. The prize ratio for doubles and singles will be at least 1 in 5 and the all-events ratio will be at least 1 in 10. A bowler is eligible to cash more than once if he/she has bowled multiple times.
- 6. OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT AVERAGE: Handicap shall be based on the highest 2017-2018 <u>USBC Final Certified</u> <u>League Average</u>. Winter and Summer averages will be used. Averages will be verified by use of the official association average books and USBC Website. If an entrant does not have a USBC average for the 2017-2018 season, they shall use the current 2018-2019 season's 21 game sanctioned league average as of 2/10/2019. This league average must be from a Certified League and the bowler must supply an average sheet or league secretary verification. Anyone not falling in one of these two options must bowl scratch with a 220 average. It is the bowler's responsibility to supply a verified certified league average sheet if they do not have a final 2017-2018 book average. Averages will be verified and corrected as necessary. Handicap structure: 90% of 220 for Singles and All-Events; 90% of 440 for Doubles.
- 7. USBC Rule 319a, item 2 (10 or more pin increase in average), 319c, 319d, and 319e **WILL NOT APPLY** in this tournament.
- 8. Report all substitutions to the Tournament Office at least 30 minutes prior to bowling.
- 9. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and the prize money will be combined and split evenly between the tied positions. Prize money payout will be: 1 division for doubles, regardless of age, 5 divisions for singles and paid all-events; these divisions are 70+, 65-69, 60-64, 55-59, 50-54.
- 10. In the event of a tie for Nation All-Events, <u>the high series with handicap in the singles event will determine the National All Events Champion</u> that will go to the National Senior's Tournament.
- 11. Since USBC has changed the 70+ division to 70-74 & 75+ divisions, this tournament will only be sending 1 bowler from the 70+ divisions (man/woman), they will bowl in whichever event their age put them in. The DSUSBC will only be sending a maximum of 5 women and 5 men to the national tournament.
- 12. Please arrive ready to bowl at least 30 minutes prior to squad time. Please check-in upon arrival.
