Tournament Rules

- 1. Eligibility: All current 2020-21 USBC youth bowlers are eligible.
- 2. Entering average: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify their own average. Average to be used in this tournament will be determined in the following order:
 - a. Highest youth 2020-21 average as of December 5, 2020.
 - b. If no 2020-21 average, highest 2019-20 winter or summer average of 21 or more games
 - c. All other bowlers must bowl scratch
- 3. Handicap: Handicap is based on 90% of team average of 600.
- 4. Team: May consist of any combination of youth bowlers.
- 5. Substitutions: Report all substitutes to the Tournament Manager at least 30 minutes prior to bowling. Once a substitute throws their first ball for score, they must finish that event.
- 6. COVID Format: Teams will bowl 9 games on the same pair, rotating on their pair but not moving pairs.
 - a. Bowler #1 bowls 1, 4, 7, 10 frames. Bowler #2 bowls 2, 5, 8, frames. Bowler #3 bowls 3, 6, 9 frames. A 9 pin count counts as a strike.
 - b. Team line up can be changed after each game but not during.
- 7. One lane courtesy only. Masks must always be worn at all times, except when eating or taking a drink.
- 8. Refunds: No refunds once tournament begins.
- 9. Check in: Team captains must check in 30 minutes prior to bowling to confirm team is present.
- 10. Scoring: When a bowler/sub is not present to bowl when the event begins, a zero will be credited for every frame missed.
 - a. Each team is responsible for recording each team score after each game.
 - b. Bowlers must certify their scores as being correct at the completion of scores bowled.
- 11. Ties: A first place tie will result in a one game roll-off with handicap by the teams tied. Other ties will split position scholarship money evenly.
- 12. Awards: Awards are based on total handicap score.
 - a. Scholarship fund returned 100% at a minimum ratio of 1:10.
- 13. Protests: all protests must be made to the reject any entrant to the Tournament Manager in writing stating the grounds. Tournament Manager has the authority to accept or reject any entrant.
- 14. Tournament limited to 12 teams based on when paid entries are received.
