## **WUSBCY TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. ALL USBC RULES ARE APPLICABLE.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY** Must be an active member of the Northern Delaware USBC Youth Bowling Association by 12/4/2021. Athletes sanctioned after 12/4/2021 are not eligible to participate in this tournament.
- 3. **AVERAGE** A bowler's average for use in the tournament is determined as follows:
  - A. Highest 2020-2021 Winter league sanctioned average; if no 2020-2021 average, then
  - B. The current year average as of 12/6/2021 with at least 9 games may be used (average sheets MUST be attached).
  - C. All other bowlers MUST bowl scratch.
- 4. AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT rule #319 is waived.
- 5. HANDICAP will be 90% of 225 for each bowler. No negative handicap.

- 6. **AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS** will be awarded separately for Singles, Doubles and Team Events. All awards/scholarships will be awarded on handicap basis at a ratio of at least 1:5 entries. The number of tournament entries in each division will determine amount of scholarships. If there is a minimum of 10 entries per division per event, there will be a guaranteed award of \$100 scholarship to the winner(s). All award/scholarship money will be returned 100% to the bowlers. A bowler with the highest pins over average scratch for a 3-game series will win a free entry into the state USBC Youth Tournament.
- 7. **SCRATCH ALL EVENTS** open to everyone who bowls in the singles, doubles, and team events. Award fees will be returned 100% and at a ratio of at least 1 scholarship for every 5 entries. There will be only **one** scratch division.
- 8. **HANDICAP ALL EVENTS** will be 90% of 225 per event. NO NEGATIVE HANDICAP. **To be eligible for the Handicap All Events Award, the athlete must bowl <u>singles, doubles & team</u> events. Highest score with handicap in each division will be awarded one paid entry of choice into the 2021-2022 DE State USBC Youth Tournament. (Entries are not transferable.) Award fees will be returned 100% and at a ratio of at least 1 scholarship for every 5 entries. There will be <b>two** handicap divisions.
- 9. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for first place in any category, co-champions will be declared, and additional awards will be given.
- 10. **LINE-UP** cannot be changed. If you are not present to bowl, a "0" will be given for each frame missed. Once a substitute has bowled the first scored ball, the substitution stands for ALL 3 games. Bowlers must get permission from a scorekeeper or official to leave the bowling enclosure.
- 11. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** are allowed in the team event provided entries are received by the tournament closing date of 10/16/2021, and at least 2 of the bowlers on the team are different. Re-entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad if there is lane availability and at the discretion of the Tournament Director. (See rule #15 below.) The scores bowled in the <u>first</u> team entry will be used towards All-Events.
- 12. NO ELECTRONICS OR CELL PHONES during tournament play. This will be strictly enforced. If you need to make a call or receive a call, please contact the tournament director as soon as possible. This will only be allowed for an emergency. The tournament director will determine if it is an emergency or not. Failure to notify the tournament director could result in disqualification.
- 13. **DRESS CODE:** Athletes must wear shirts that cover the entire midriff area and have a collar like golf or polo shirts. (Mock turtlenecks with a sport logo (such as nike) or tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC are acceptable.)
  - A. Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
  - B. Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, illegal substance, and gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.
  - C. Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.
  - D. No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons.)
  - E. All clothing apparel must be the correct clothing size for the bowler. (Ex; if wear med shirt do not wear XXXL shirt.) Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official's decision will be final.
- **14. 50-50 TICKETS** will be sold to benefit the Award/Scholarship Fund.
- 15. **PROTESTS/APPEALS** All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless a protest/appeal is filed within 72 hours in accordance with Rule #329.
- **16. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT AVERAGE SHEETS AND PAYMENT**. All entries must be received by 10/16/2021. Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad if there is lane availability and at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
