## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

This tournament is open to all youth bowlers 8 and under who participate in an organized Pee Wee (bumpers) sanctioned league program of NDUSBCY. This tournament is certified by USBC and all USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern.

- 1. Highest 2023-2024 Winter league sanctioned average.
- 2. If the bowler does not have a 2023-2024 winter league sanctioned average but participated in a 2024 Summer NDUSBCA Sanctioned league and had 21 games or more in the league, they can use that average.
- 3. If the bowler does not have a sanctioned average as stated in either 1 or 2, then the bowler will use the current year average if there have been 10 games bowled through and including 11/11/24.
  - \*\*\*Average sheet must be provided prior to start of competition for proof of correct average.
- **4.** If the bowler does not have a qualifying sanctioned bumper league average as stated above then bowler MUST BOWL SCRATCH (No Handicap).
- 5. AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT RULE #319 IS WAIVED.
- **6.** HANDICAP WILL BE 80% of 200.
- 7. AWARDS / SCHOLARSHIPS---will be awarded for Singles scores on a handicap basis, at a ratio of at least one for every 5 Singles entries.
- 8. TIES: In the event of any ties prizes for the positions affected will be equally divided.
- **9. RESPONSIBILITY:** If you are not present to bowl any frame when it is your turn to bowl, a score of zero ("0"), will be given for each frame missed. If you need to leave your bowling lanes, please advise a Tournament official. (*Example allowance would be for bathroom needs.*)

- 10. NO PLAYING VIDEOS / HANDHELD GAMES DURING COMPETITION. E-readers, MP3 players, or i-pods will be allowed only in music or reading mode. They will not be allowed on the approaches while the bowler is bowling, including all wired or wireless earpieces which are to be removed prior to stepping on the approach to bowl. No cell phones will be allowed during competition. If you need to make a call, please contact the Tournament Director as soon as possible. This will only be allowed in an emergency. Failure to notify Tournament Director could result in disqualification.
- 11. Dress Code: Participants in the Tournament must be neat in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:
  - **a.** Shirts Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar like golf or polo shirts. (Tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC are acceptable)
  - **b.** Shirts must cover the entire midriff area or be tucked in.
  - c. Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
  - **d.** Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, and gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.
  - e. Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.
  - f. No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons)
  - g. All clothing must be the correct clothing size. (Example: if you normally wear a small shirt do not wear an extra large shirt). Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official's decisions will be final.
- **12.** Bowlers will participate in a league style format, changing lanes each frame. To keep a consistent pace, one lane courtesy will be observed.
- 13. All bowlers must check in at the tournament desk at least ½ hour prior to scheduled bowling time. No Substitutions will be permitted.
- **14.** Bowlers arriving late will begin play and the score will count beginning with that frame. Missed frames will be credited with a zero. A bowler not present to bowl when it is their turn will receive a zero for that frame. (*If a bowler needs to step away to use a bathroom, a tournament official must be notified before leaving the assigned bowling lanes.*)
- **15.** Bowlers will be allowed 10 minutes of practice on their starting pair.
- **16.** Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
- **17.** *SCORING*: 2 games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes, with handicap. Highest score plus handicap will determine the winner.
- 18. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director within 48 hours or before the awards are distributed. Tournament Director will be the final authority. Each protest under this rule must be specific.
- **19.** Returned checks are subject to a \$45.00 charge, and that person will no longer be permitted to write checks to the NDUSBCA Tournament. The NDUSBCA Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept/to reject any participant.

All Matters not covered by these rules shall be determined by the Tournament Committee. Make checks payable to NDUSBCA. ALL ENTRIES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE
